Reading

- Scan the passage before reading in detail
 - Focus on main ideas, not every word
 - Don't get stuck on unknown words
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Listening

- Take short, fast notes — don't write full sentences
 - Focus on tone and attitude — they're tested
 - Listen to academic podcasts to train your ear
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Speaking

- Always answer with structure: intro, reason, example
 - Record yourself and review — notice patterns
 - Speak with confidence, not perfection
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Writing

- Follow templates — don't try to improvise on test day
 - Keep your writing clear and logical
 - Use transitions like “in addition,” “however,” and “for example”
